The South Alabama Antique Tractor and engine Club is offering a \$500 scholarship to a FFA High School senior.

1. Applicant must be a resident of Baldwin County, in the state of Alabama.
2. Applicant must be studying in an agriculture related field or parents are directly involved in the farming industry (cattle, hay, horses, corn, soybeans, cotton, etc.).
3. Applicant must have a 3.0 or higher GPA in high school and maintain a cumulative GPA above 3.0 during the fall and spring college semesters.
4. Applicant must have been admitted to an accredited post-secondary institution.
5. Students applying for the scholarship must submit their application no later than March 1<sup>st</sup> of their senior year. Applications not post marked by the specified deadline of March 1<sup>st</sup> will not be considered.
6. Application instructions (Please submit your packet in this order):
  - ( ) All information in the application must be complete. Be sure you, a parent and your High School Counselor sign the application.
  - ( ) Submit one (1) letter of reference from a teacher.
  - ( ) Submit one (1) letter of reference from a **community member other than a teacher or family member.**
  - ( ) Submit a two (2) page essay describing your academic and career objectives, reason for applying for this scholarship, financial need and any other information related to your application.

Keep the Rules Pertaining to Scholarship Applicants/Recipients for future reference if selected for the scholarship these rules will be used to maintain your eligibility, and also include information about the selection process.

Be sure your application is complete and includes all required materials. Incomplete applications will not be considered and will be returned.

Entries will be judged based on professionalism, qualifications, commitment to career, letters of recommendation and need.
